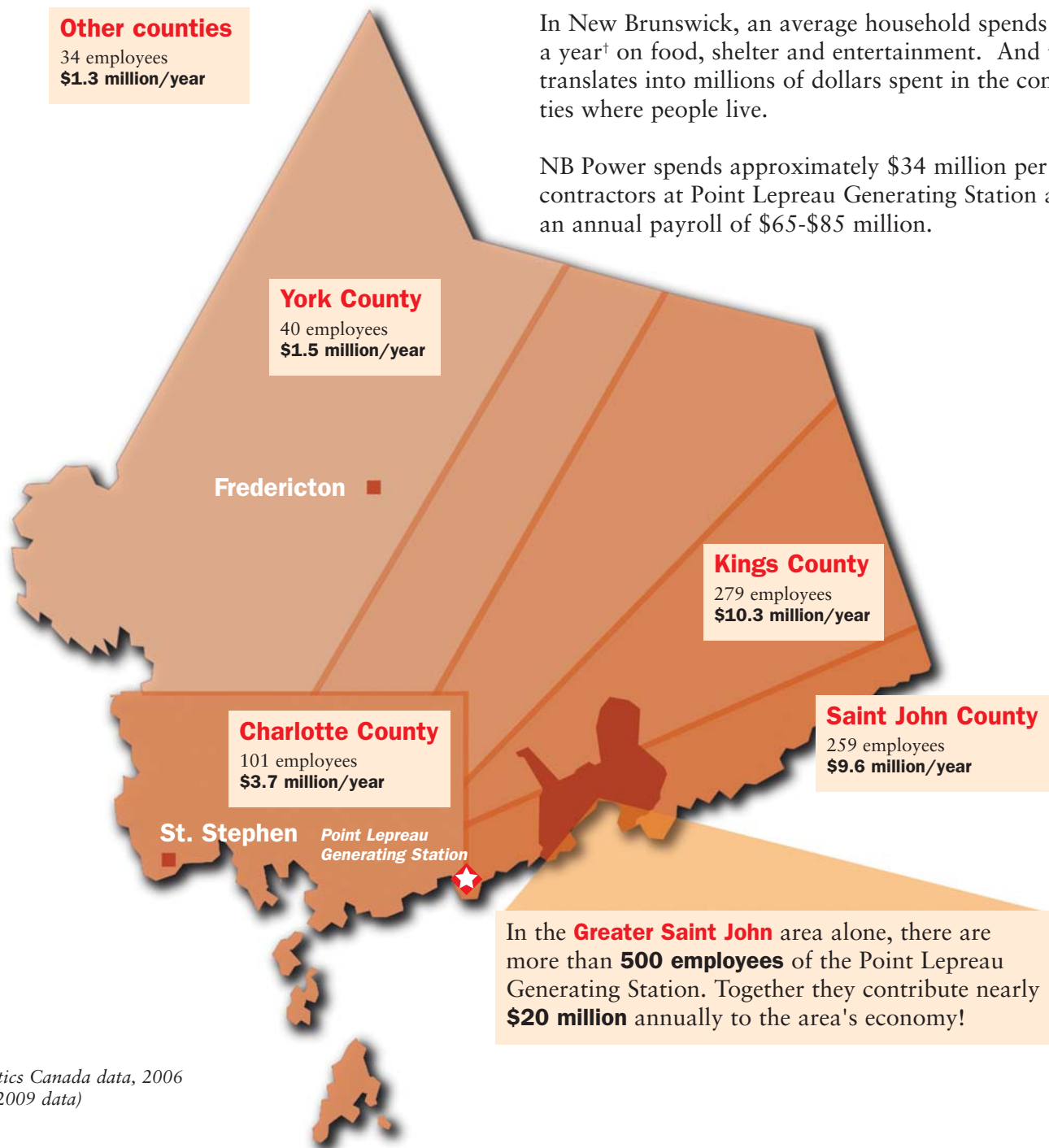


Contribution to the New Brunswick Economy

Point Lepreau Generating Station employs approximately 800 people as regular employees, of whom more than 500 are in the Greater Saint John area (communities of Saint John, Grand Bay-Westfield, Rothesay, Gondola Point, Quispamsis).

In New Brunswick, an average household spends \$36,982 a year[†] on food, shelter and entertainment. And that translates into millions of dollars spent in the communities where people live.

NB Power spends approximately \$34 million per year on contractors at Point Lepreau Generating Station and has an annual payroll of \$65-\$85 million.
