

Instructions on how to complete your Statement of Work

Step 1 – Fill in the NB Power Energy Smart Participant Reference Number and Building Name at the top of the page (see Figure # 1 below). The reference number can be found in your Welcome to NB Power email that was sent with your Program Agreement.




Figure 1 - Efficiency NB Energy Smart Participant Reference Number for the Request for Payment.

Step 2A– Fill in the Energy Efficiency Measure(s) that you plan on implementing (see Figure # 2 of the following page). Your Summary Report Form, provided to you with your Energy Audit, will show all of the Energy Efficiency Measures that you may select. (On your Summary Report Form see the Recommendations on page 2). You do not need to select all the Energy Efficiency Measures, if you chose, you may select just one.

Note: When referring to the Energy Efficiency Measures in the Summary Report Form there is a payback period that is indicated for each measure. This payback period indicates the number of years it will take you to pay back the cost of implementing that Energy Efficiency Measure with the money that you save on your power bill. The payback period is a useful piece of information when determining which Energy Efficiency Measures to select.

Step 2B– Fill in the Estimated Cost, Energy Avoidance and Comments (see Figure #2 of the following page) for each Energy Efficiency Measure that you selected. These can also be found on your Summary Report Form under the Recommendations on page 2.

Note: the comments field is for any extra details that may be relevant to the Energy Efficiency Measure.
