Interested parties can request to intervene in the proceeding. This involves filing written information requests, filing evidence, responding to information requests, and participation in motions and hearings.





LETTERS OF COMMENT

Those who are not intervening in a hearing can submit letters of comment to the Board for consideration in relation to the application.

PUBLIC FORUM

The Board may set a date for a



public forum for those who would like to make oral comments. Submissions will be considered by the Board.

Evidence and related documents are available publicly on the NBEUB's website, subject to any claims for confidentiality. Transcripts of proceedings are also available on the website. Members of the public may attend a hearing, either in person or virtually.
